NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2 The Championship will be hosted by the Yacht Club of Hyderabad, Secunderabad Sailing Club, EME Sailing Association and the Artillery Water Sports Association in association with the Sports Authority of Andhra Pradesh.

2.0 ADVERTISING

2.1 The event is classified as Category C in accordance with the ISAF advertising code. All boats will be required to display the following on each side of the hull:-

(a) A bow number on the forward 600 mm of the hull. Bow numbers shall be allotted by the organizers.

(b) Advertising of the event sponsor, if any.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

3.1 Clubs affiliated to the NHCA are eligible to field teams in the event.

3.2 Teams are required to complete the attached form and send it together with a draft (payable at Hyderabad) for the prescribed fee and damage deposit to National Hobie Class Association, C/o Watermanship Training Cell, HQ Artillery Centre, Golconda, Ibrahimbagh P.O, Hyderabad -500 031 by 31 Jul 09.

3.3 Late entries shall be accepted up to 11 Aug 2009.

4.0 FEES

4.1 Entry fees for participants bringing own boats and submitting entries upto 31 Jul 09 - Rs 500/- per entry.

4.2 Entry Fees for participants making use of boats provided by organizers and submitting entries by 31 Jul 09 – Rs. 3000/-

4.3 Late fee for entries received after 31 Jul 09 is Rs 100/- per entry.

4.4 Refundable Damage deposit for participants making use of boats provided by organizers - Rs 2500/- per entry.

4.5 Where participants are making use of boats being provided by organizers, each team shall, for the entire duration of the championship, maintain a credit balance for Damage Deposit. In the event of any damage occurring and money being paid from a teams deposit, that team would have to pay in addition to the deposit to the extent of expenditure incurred before being allowed to race further.

5.0 **BOATS AND EQUIPMENT**

5.1 Attempt are being made by the organizers to make limited number of boats available on charter further details shall be given on request

5.2 Participants are required to bring their own personal flotation devices and trapeze harnesses.

5.3 In the event of boats being made available on charter, participants may be called upon the Organizing Committee for assistance in assembling them for racing. Distribution of boats on charter shall be made by the Organizing Secretary and his decision in the matter shall be final.

5.4 Participants using boats given by the organizers will have undertake to make good damage to equipment (i.e mast, boom, tiller cross bars, trapeze handles etc) **INCLUDING COMPLETE REPLACEMENT OF SUCH PART AT SUCH RATE DETERMINED BY THE ORGANIZING AUTHORITY**, should the same be damaged/bracken by the competitor (whether due to omission. commission/otherwise) during the tenure of charter. **Decision of the Organizing Authority in this regard shall be final.**

6.0 **SCHEDULE**

6.1 The schedule is as under: -

6.2 Format and firm timing of races will be intimated at the time of registration and will be displayed on the official Notice Board. Any changes will be intimated subsequently.

7.0 **MEASUREMENTS**

7.1 Participants bringing own boats are required to produce a valid measurement certificate.

8.0 **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

8.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available after of registration.

9.0 **VENUE**

9.1 The event shall be sailed off the Artillery Water Sports Centre Secunderabad.

10.0 **COURSE**

10.1 The course(s) to be sailed shall be displayed on the official notice board and also described in the sailing instructions.

11.0 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 The penalty for infringement of a rule of part 2 shall be one turn, including one tack and one gybe. This changes Rule 44.1 and 44.2.

12.0 RADIO COMMUNICATION

12.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13.0 PRIZES

13.1 Prize will be awarded to the following categories of Sailors:-

- (a) The winner of the National Championship.
- (b) The 1st and 2nd runners up.

14.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15.0 SELECTION CRITERIA

15.1 Performance in these Nationals will not be the selection criteria for participation in international events in the Hobie 16 Class planned in the summer of 2009. Participation in all international events is subject to approval of the YAI Selection Committee and the Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.

16.0 FURTHER INFORMATION

16.1 All participants shall arrange for their own boarding and lodging. Efforts are being made to arrange for accommodation closer to the venue on payment. For confirmation, participants are requested to contact the Honorary Secretary.

16.2 Lunch and snacks shall be provided onsite to all participants during the regatta. Transportation for participants is being arranged.
